WEB RESOURCES

Web based creation of lab user accounts and Fontbonne University e-mail accounts;

Using Fontbonne Onramp (<http://onramp.campus.fontbonne.edu>), students are able to activate their username and password for Fontbonne E-mail. This same process allows students to retrieve forgotten passwords and/or change passwords.

Fontbonne University email accounts are accessible via the web at <http://mail.campus.fontbonne.edu> using Open Web Mail. Open Web Mail is customizable to the student needs with calendar, address book, etc. And it allows students to use e-mail without annoying advertisements and pop-ups that come with hotmail or similar programs.

Students have wireless Internet access in their dorm rooms and other locations on campus. To access wireless, computers must have an operating 802.11g wireless card. Once a computer is configured for wireless access using the Cisco Clean Agent and a problem arises, they can contact information technology at 719-8095.

Students can check academic progress, grades, and register via the web by going to our home page: <http://www.fontbonne.edu/>.

- Click the “Shortcuts for ...” drop down in upper right corner
- Choose “Current Students” from the list.
- Click the Student Information Management link.

This access requires username and password:

For all students the username is the student id number. The password is initially set to the home zip code. Student Information Management login problems should be directed to the registrar’s office at 889-1421. Students may change their passwords after they login. For security purposes, we strongly recommend that students change their password on a regular basis.

Students have access to library databases via the web whether they are on campus or off. Off-campus access requires authentication using the last name as the username and student ID number followed by F for the password. If students have any problems with the library databases they can contact the Library at 889-1417.



COMPUTER LABS

- **Ryan Hall** – All these labs have academic classes scheduled in them, but are available for student use whenever no classes are scheduled.
 - **Room 303**- 21 PCs with Windows XP, MS Office 2003, Internet Explorer, and other various packages related to specific courses, all connected to the Internet. There are 3 HP laser printers, a scanner and projection equipment available.
 - **Room 305** – 21 PCs with Windows XP, MS Office 2003, Internet Explorer, and other various packages related to specific courses, all connected to the Internet. There are 2 HP laser printers, a scanner and projection equipment available.
 - **Room 307** - 11 PCs that are always open for student use. These PCs have Windows XP, MS office 2003, Internet Explorer, Mathematica, Minitab and other various software packages related to specific courses. Also, available are 4 G4s with OS X, Apple Works, MS Office 2001 and Internet Explorer. All equipment is connected to the Internet. There is an HP laser printer, a scanner, and color laser also available
 - **Room 309** - 21 PCs with Windows XP, MS Office 2003, Internet Explorer, Visual Basic, and other various software packages related to specific courses, all connected to the Internet. There are 2 HP laser printers and projection equipment available.
 - **Internet Lab (Library)** – 42 PCs are available for students whenever the Library is open with Windows XP, MS Office 2003, and Internet Explorer. There are 4 HP laser printers and a scanner available.
 - **AMC (Medaille Hall)** – 10 PCs with Windows XP, and MS Office 2003, and Internet Explorer, all connected to the Internet. There are 3 HP laser printers available.
 - **St. Joseph Hall** – 5 PCs with Windows XP, MS Office 2003, and Internet Explorer, all connected to the Internet. There is an HP laser printer available.
 - **Southwest Hall** – 4 PCs with Windows XP, MS Office 2003, and Internet Explorer, all connected to the Internet. There is an HP laser printer available.
- Other resources
 - Server based storage of personal information and data that is automatically backed up by the IT Department on a daily basis. This information is available through the web at <https://files.campus.fontbonne.edu>, using the same username and password that you use for your Fontbonne E-mail.
