



## Midwest Student Exchange Program Eligibility Form

### Program Information:

The Midwestern Higher Education Compact helps improve access to postsecondary education through the Midwest Student Exchange Program (MSEP). Since 1994, the MSEP has provided more affordable opportunities for students to attend out-of-state institutions. The MSEP serves as the Midwest's largest multi-state tuition reciprocity program. MSEP is not a scholarship. Through the MSEP, public institutions agree to charge students no more than 150% of the in-state resident tuition rate for specific programs; **private institutions offer a 10% reduction on their tuition rates**. You must be enrolling as a non-resident student at a participating MSEP campus to receive the discount.

### Fontbonne University Information:

To qualify for the Midwest Student Exchange Program at Fontbonne University, students must have permanent residence in one of the following states: Illinois, Indiana, Kansas, Michigan, Minnesota, Missouri, Nebraska, North Dakota and Wisconsin. **Please complete the form below and return to the Office of Admission (mail, fax, or scan & email) by May 31st.**
