

There are various places on the audit that say things like 'credits required' and 'credits completed.' Credit hour information on the audit doesn't add electives into its calculation. If you want to know the total credits you have completed, look at your transcript for the hours earned. To graduate you must complete all the required elements on your degree audit and earn a minimum of 120 credit hours.
